Covid-19 and Teaching

Dear Colleagues:

We are in the midst of an evolving environment and we are following the guidelines of the Yamhill County Public Health and Oregon Health Authority. We will use their guidelines regarding closures. At this point, there are no known positive cases in Yamhill county and limited cases in Multnomah county.

We are in a state of readiness should an institutional decision need to be made to move classes online. Please stress the readiness message to students and do not get ahead of institutional messaging. President Davis speaks as the official Linfield voice and he will have a message in *Linfield Ahead* tomorrow morning.
